CAC'S CHILD-FOCUSED DV PROGRAM

Safe from the Start serves children ages 0-5 who have experienced domestic violence in their family relationships.

SFTS COALITION

As the only **SFTS** program site in our area, CAC coordinates a coalition of 34 local partners who provide additional community resources for client families.

MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING



CAC's Trauma Therapists provided 121 hours of **family therapy** and 674 hours of **individual therapy** for **SFTS** clients in English and Spanish in Fiscal Year 2024.
